
K-5, Half-Hour Assembly

In my school assembly presentation, we learn about ideas, writing a book, and our different brains.

I show students my process of writing SAWYER'S BIG IDEA, about a boy with big ideas and a very busy mind. I talk about writing, research, and the importance of editing. Then we read the book and look for ways we relate to Sawyer's creative process, with a few minutes for Q&A. This presentation works great for the whole school, or broken into K-2 and Gr.3-5 groups, to focus more on age-appropriate writing challenges.
